

2019's data continues to show how amazing you are!

You have allowed us to serve a total of 195 individuals. You've assisted 64 single parents, (including our current participants) and 131 children, YTD. Furthermore, due to your actions 36 single parents have graduated from our program and have increased their income, on average; from \$20,663 to \$32,942. That had a major impact for these graduates.






Average income of \$17,622 or \$8.47 per hourly income, which is only \$400 over the FPL.

33% of our participants are first generation college attendees in their perspective families.

Our top three collegiate referrals for our participants were: Fortis College (58%), Georgia State University (17%), and Gwinnett Technical College (8%).

ACADEMICS

With an average of a year and ten months in the program, our current participants have shown validated growth. 100% of our program participants are on track to graduate on time, less than a six-year time frame, as stated and encouraged in our goals. They have maintained an average GPA of 3.36.





To coincide with our 10th year anniversary, we celebrated the graduation from college of ten single parents that successfully completed their degrees. Ten for ten! We are very proud of the fact that this was our largest graduating class to date!

Savings & Financial Stability



Before starting our program, 33% of our participants did not have a savings account. Now, 88% of them do, with 11% over \$500.



Currently, 44% of our participants improved their credit scores since beginning the program.



After graduating and being employed, 11% of our participants own their own home already.

My name is Laverne, and I am a single parent of five. When I first applied for H.O.P.E. Inc., I was working full time, and I was in the process of achieving my Associates Degree in Education. I struggled month to month trying to maintain housing, and keep up with my rent. It was a hard process because I didn't make enough to stay current. I constantly received late fees and evictions letters on my door. It was stressful! I kept praying and looking for a way out because I knew I needed help.

I had the opportunity to meet wonderful volunteers, and their support helped me survive! The skills I learned in this program are life changing! I never took time out to learn about equal pay rights and other self-managing skills I needed in life before. My focus was always on paying rent and bills.

I also thank you for providing training for my children. My children were able to attend workshops and events where they learned life skills and met other children in the program. You even removed the stress I experienced during the holidays. You made a huge impact on our Christmas and Thanksgiving! I am grateful for how this program has impacted my life. You gave me hope and a positive attitude in life! You gave me the strength and courage I needed to succeed. In this program, I was never alone.

Not only did you change my life, but you changed the course of my two daughters, who graduated from high school in May of 2018. You were there from prom to the end of high school providing support. Thank you for allowing Mrs. Kenita to share her vision with me and my family! I am so grateful for an awesome mentor, leader and Woman of God who truly has a heart for all single parents. She was there for me anytime I needed her support. She didn't only help me financially, she helped me spiritually by watching her life.
